





Leaving Certificate Vocational Programme



- The LCVP is a Leaving Certificate subject with a Vocational dimension.
- Vocational refers to the development of a range of key 'Transferable Skills'.



Transferable Skills used in LCVP

- Team Working
- Critical Thinking
- Flexibility
- Leadership
- Planning

- IT Skills
- Motivation to Learn
- Communication
- Initiative & Enterprise
- Decision Making

These skills are equally relevant to young people progressing to further study, working for themselves or going directly into employment.

Students:

- Take responsibility for their own learning.
- Become more innovative and enterprising.
- Communicate their thoughts and ideas effectively.
- Investigate and plan their career options.

- Develop key skills for the modern working environment.
- Work well as part of a team.
- Network with people in business and the community.
- Access and use computers and improve IT skills.



Programme Requirements

Pupils must study the following, in order to qualify for LCVP...

- 1. Must take a minimum of 5 Leaving Certificate Subjects including Irish (if exempt from Irish you need to take additional subject to bring you to quota of 5 subjects)
- 2. Must study the two link Modules, namely Preparation for the World of Work and Enterprise Education

Work Enterprise Education (Units)

- Enterprise Skills
- Local Business enterprises
- Local voluntary organisations / community enterprises
- An enterprise activity




Typical LCVP Activities

Link Modules Assessment



 The Link Modules are assessed by written examination and portfolio



Portfolio of Coursework (50%)

This is a typed project which is completed in January of the Leaving Certificate Year.

It comprises of 5 short projects including:

- 1) CV
- 2) Enterprise Plan
- 3) Career Investigation
- 4) Summary Report
- 5) Report on their own locality called 'My Own Place'.



Recorded Interview (10%)

This interview is video taped.
 It is an interview that tests
 both their communication
 skills and knowledge.

 These interviews take place in February of their Leaving Certificate year.



Written Examination (40%)

This takes place at the start of May of the Leaving Cert year.
